1. All new registrants to the Nova Scotia College of Chiropractors will be Peer Assessed within the initial 12 months of their initial registration.
2. All members of the Nova Scotia College of Chiropractors will be Peer Assessed a minimum of once per five (5) years.
3. Peer Assessments may also be utilized for issues of member re-classification, at the request of a member, or upon the request of the Investigative or Discipline Committees of the Board of the NSCC.
4. Peer Assessors are to have a minimum of three (3) years practice experience.
5. The following persons may not be Peer Assessors:
 - a.) Chair of the Board of the NSCC
 - b.) President of the Council of the NSCC
 - c.) Registrar of the NSCC
 - d.) Member of the Investigative Committee of the Board of the NSCC
