Preceptorships

- A. Preceptorships are permitted with NSCC members in good standing.
- B. A preceptor may perform adjunctive functions for which he/she has been trained under the supervision of a registered NSCC member. These may include:
 - 1. History taking
 - 2. Physical examination procedures
 - 3. Application of therapeutic modalities
- C. A preceptor may perform the acts of diagnosis and chiropractic treatment only under the supervision of the registered NSCC member.
- D. A preceptor may provide acupuncture treatment as a modality only if certified by the Board as per regulation.
- E. NSCC members participating in preceptorships must have appropriate professional liability insurance for such activity.
