Chiropractors who have not been previously licensed to practice in Canada and are seeking licensure in Nova Scotia are required to fulfill the following criteria:

1. Successful completion of CCEB Cognitive examination.
2. Successful completion of CCEB Clinical Skills examination within the past three (3) years.
3. Successful completion of Nova Scotia Jurisprudence and Ethics examination with the past year.
4. Completion of any additional registration requirements as outlined by the Chiropractic Act, Regulations and Policies of the Board of the Nova Scotia College of Chiropractors.
