The Board of the Nova Scotia College of Chiropractors requires all registered members to take the NSCC approved Record Keeping Workshop every five years. This course will be offered through the College.

The purpose of this regulation is to uphold the College Code of Ethics, specifically Article 1, Section 2: 2.1 which states:

“The chiropractor will keep a patient file, which will include the patient’s name and address, history information, physical examination findings, radiographic examinations, investigations ordered and their results, the diagnosis, treatment plan, and record of patient visits”.
